MS. URBAN: Good morning. Welcome to this meeting of the California Privacy Protection Agency Board. It's January 27th, 2025 at 9:26 p.m. We apologize for our delay. There was a very difficult traffic situation in the Bay Area this morning. My name is Jennifer Urban. I'm the chairperson of the Board and I'm very pleased to be here with the Board and to welcome some of you on Zoom.

To begin, I'd first like to acknowledge the extremely difficult circumstances many of our fellow Californians are facing due to the wild -- devastating wildfires in Southern California. I'm sure that I speak on behalf of all of us on the Board when I say that our thoughts are with everyone who is affected, you are in our hearts.

We also want to acknowledge the bravery and tenacity of the firefighting teams and other first responders who have courageously put themselves in harm's way to protect the safety of others, the agencies and local organizations and volunteers working to provide relief and stability and to

everyone who is contributing to the effort. We know that rebuilding lives, homes and livelihoods will require a long-term effort and we and all of California are behind you, not just until the fires end, but as you work to rebuild.

Relatedly, I wanted to make sure that everyone was aware of the extended deadline for our current rulemaking in light of those catastrophic fires. The CPPA announced earlier this month that we have extended the formal comment period for our current proposed rulemaking package from January 14th to February 19th.

In addition, we have added a second public comment hearing on the draft regulations package for those who prefer to provide public comment orally. This second meeting will be on Wednesday, February 19th, which is the same day the public comment closes.

As was the case for the first public hearing. Attendees can join us either in person in Sacramento or remotely via Zoom. All of the meeting information along with more details about how to provide public comments and the draft regulation package can be found on our website, which is cppa.ca gov.

Turning attention back to today's meeting it will be run according to the Bagley-Keene open meeting act as required by law. We will proceed through the agenda, which is available at a handout -- as a handout here in San Francisco and also on the CPPA website. Materials for the meeting are also available as handouts here and on the website.

Today's agenda is related to two closed session items. First is discussion of impossible action on the appointments of an executive director and chief privacy auditor. That is under authority of government code Section 11126(a)(1).

And pursuant to government code Section 1126(e)(1) and (2)(a), the Board will also meet in closed session to confer and receive advice from legal counsel regarding litigation for which disclosing the names would jeopardize the agency's ability to conclude existing settlement negotiations.

I do anticipate that the closed session discussions will last for most of the day. Once closed session ends, we will come back to open session for agenda item three, which is adjournment. My thanks to the Board members for their service and to everyone working to make this meeting possible. I would like to thank the team supporting us today, Mr.
