
Delete Request and Opt-Out Platform (DROP) System Update

Data Broker Legal Requirements

- Register annually (including payment of registration fee)
- Update mandatory public disclosures
 July 1 every year to report previous
 year activity

- Process consumer deletion requests at least once every 45 days
- Undergo independent audit every three years starting January 1, 2028

The Agency is partnering with the California Department of Technology (CDT) to build the Delete Request and Opt-Out Platform (DROP) system.



Project includes supplemental IT procurements to support DROP development.


DROP System Overview: Consumer Experience

- ID VERIFICATION
 Verify residency using a third party
- 2 CONSUMER PERSONAL INFORMATION Provide a minimal amount of personal information & authentication of certain data elements
- SUBMIT REQUEST
 Submit the request to all or a subset of registered data brokers
- CHECK STATUS
 Check status and/or update your deletion request in 45 days

DROP System Overview: Data Broker Experience

Identify matches Create account Complete **Delete records and** registration, maintain including payment suppression list **Choose consumer** Report deletion deletion lists status within 45 based on days identifier(s) **Download deletion** list via API or manually 1x every 45 days

How it Works



- Personal information stored in hashed format
- Limited personal information released based on data broker records

DROP System Overview: Agency Functionality

- Facilitate annual registration
- Audit compliance and investigate violations
- Verify consumer residency
- Support consumers and data brokers

Delete Request and Opt-Out Platform (DROP) and Data Broker Registration

Data Broker Regulations

Data Broker Requirements:

- 1. Account creation
- 2. Accessing and processing deletion requests
- 3. Reporting status of deletion requests to DROP
- 4. Deactivating account or ceasing to access deletion requests

Data Broker Regulations

Consumer and Authorized Agent Deletion Requests:

- 1. Residency verification, including ability to request review of residency
- 2. Deletion request content and process
- 3. Authorized Agent disclosure

NEXT STEPS

System Development: Continue DROP development, with testing to begin in fall 2025

Rulemaking: Commence formal rulemaking to ensure compliance with DROP launch in 2026

Public Awareness: Prepare education and promotion campaign for the public and data brokers
