






Categories of Complaints


MOST COMMON

Right to limit









Enforcement Evolution: Notable Consumer Protection Laws, 1800s-today




State Regulators Form Bipartisan Consortium to Collaborate on Privacy Issues

News: April 16, 2025

SACRAMENTO, CA – Eight state regulators are collaborating on the implementation and enforcement of their privacy laws with the shared goal of protecting consumers. The Consortium of Privacy Regulators is a bipartisan effort that includes state Attorneys General and the California Privacy Protection Agency.
