Sponsored Bill – SB 923 (Becker)

Expanding Privacy Rights Act – amends CCPA



Expand the right to delete to allow deletion of all personal information, no matter the source

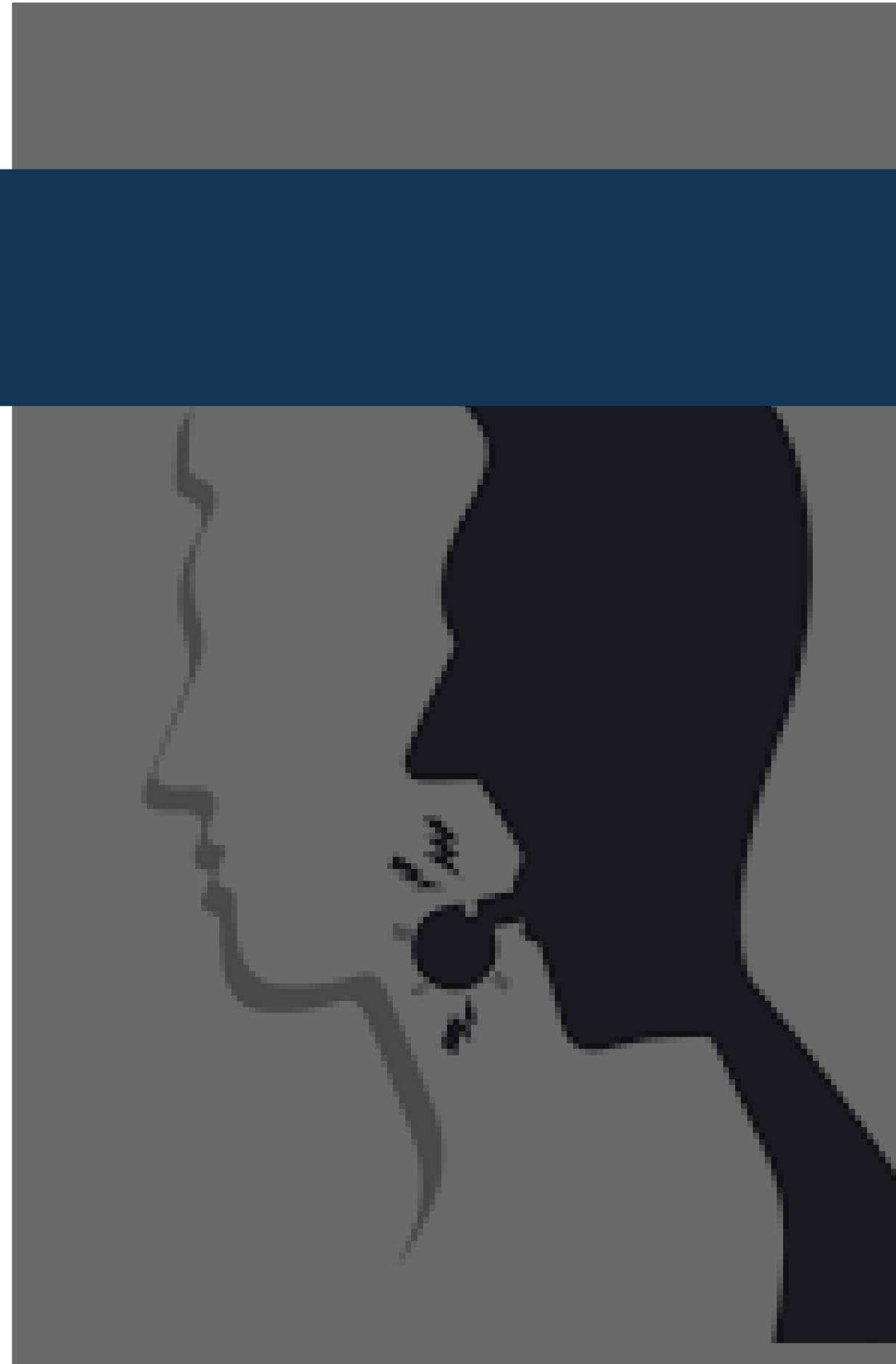


Require online businesses to offer multiple methods to submit privacy requests, such as webform

CCPA Whistleblower Bill Update

Two Key Components

- ***Award Program*** – Incentivize whistleblowers to come forward with information by allowing them to share a portion of the administrative fine
- ***Anti-Retaliation*** – Protect whistleblowers from retaliation



Early Watch Bills

AB 883 (Lowenthal) – amends the Delete Act to provide increased protections and streamlined processing for elected officials and judges

AB 1159 (Addis) — amends existing educational privacy laws to prohibit the use of covered information to train AI systems

AB 1542 (Ward) – amends the CCPA to restrict the sale and sharing of sensitive personal information

SB 1104 (Cabaldon) - amends the CCPA to require that businesses that do not operate exclusively online provide an email address for privacy requests

SB 1106 (Cabaldon) - amends the Delete Act to require data brokers to access DROP and process deletion requests every 30 days instead of every 45 days

Multistate Update

Half dozen active Delete-style bills

- Including HI, IL, NE, NM, NY, VT

Comprehensive privacy bills active in several states

- Including IL, ME, MA, NM, NY, PA, WI

Federal Update

House Energy & Commerce Committee Bills

- ▶▶▶▶ Committee markup of kids' internet bills expected. Staff monitoring amendments to COPPA, including language impacting states
- ▶▶▶▶ Committee comprehensive privacy bill expected after review of kids bills

AI Executive Order – Dept. Of Commerce Evaluation of State AI Laws

- ▶▶▶▶ Expected in March
- ▶▶▶▶ Staff monitoring what state laws are identified
